

What is Flocking & How Does it Work???

Flocking Migration Dates: October 1 – November 30, 2008



Official Detailed Flocking Donation Rules & Regulations

Visit the United Way Flocking Instructions whenever you want to know where, when, how, etc...

\$1.00 Per Flamingo - You can donate \$1.00 to have one flamingo migrated into someone's cube for an 8-hour incubation period.

\$10.00 Mass Flocking - You can donate \$10.00 to have the entire flock of flamingoes, lights, confetti, flamingo signage migrated into someone's cube for an 8-hour incubation period.

\$ 5.00 No Flocking Protection Policy - You can donate \$5.00 and receive a "No Flocking Policy" that you can prominently display in your cube & be put on the "No Flocking" policy list so no flocking will occur in your cube throughout the flocking dates.

Flamingoes will nest for an 8-hour incubation period in the current nesting arena - Each flocking will incubate for one day in the nesting ground to which you donated \$10.00.

\$1.00 - \$5.00 Donation to get (de-flamingoed) - The flockee will need to donate \$1.00 to migrate the flock out of their cube (unless they are a "No Flock Policy" holder). However, they will need to donate \$10.00 to migrate the flock into someone else's nesting ground

\$1.00 Donation for any known mistreatment or neglect to any flamingo - We ask that there be no mistreatment or neglect to any of our TSO flamingoes; however watchful eyes can let us know if there is and that person will be required to donate \$1.00 for each misdemeanor.

Logistics Details:

- There will be two Flocking Teams that will migrate the flocks from one nesting ground to the next.
- Donations can be given to any one of the Flocking Team Members listed on Rules & Regulations Page

Terms:

Migrate: Pronunciation: 'ml-"grAt, ml-'

1 : to move from one country, place, or locality to another

2 : to pass usually periodically from one region or climate to another for feeding or breeding

Nest: Pronunciation: \'nest\

1 : to build or occupy a nest : settle in or as if in a nest

2 : to fit compactly together or within one another

Donate: Pronunciation: \'dō-,nāt, dō-\'

1. to make a gift of; *especially* : to contribute to a public or charitable cause

Flocking: Pronunciation: \'flāk\

1 : a group of animals (as birds or sheep) assembled or herded together

Flamingo: Pronunciation \flē-'miŋ-(,)gō\

1 : any of several large aquatic birds (family Phoenicopteridae) with long legs and neck, webbed feet, a broad lamellate bill resembling that of a duck but abruptly bent downward, and usually rosy-white plumage with scarlet wing coverts and black wing quills
