Conflict of Interest and Business Ethics

Certain activities sponsored by Pikes Peak United Way may pose an actual or potential "conflict of interest" with a member of the PPUW Board of Directors or a PPUW staff member. The following will serve as a guide to the possible types of activities that might cause conflicts of interest and that should be fully reported to the President/CEO or to the Chairman of the Board of Directors.

- To hold, directly or indirectly, a position or financial interest in any outside concern from which PPUW secures goods or services.
- To hold, directly or indirectly, a position or financial interest in any outside concerns that competes, directly or indirectly, with PPUW.
- To render managerial or consultative services to any outside concern that does business with, or directly competes with, PPUW.
- To accept excessive gifts, entertainment, or other excessive favors from any outside concern that does, or is seeking to do, business with, or is a competitor of PPUW.
- To participate, directly or indirectly, in any matter involving PPUW where the Board Member, employee, or a member of his/her family has a direct or indirect financial interest.

Full disclosure of any situation in doubt should be made so as to permit an impartial and objective determination.
