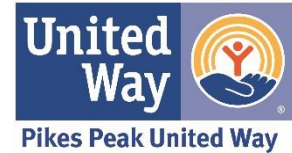

Free Tax Assistance Program Kicks off this Saturday at Pikes Peak United Way

Colorado Springs, CO, January 27, 2018 – Tax season is underway and Pikes Peak United Way is providing free income tax help to individuals who may qualify for the federal Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC). Now through April 15, trained volunteers at six local sites will help bring millions of dollars to working people with low and moderate incomes. Individuals with annual incomes of less than \$54,000 may call 2-1-1 to schedule an appointment for free tax assistance.

EITC refunds could mean a \$6,200 return, depending on family size and income. Millions of dollars in tax credits go unclaimed each year because people don't know about them or don't know how to apply for them. According to the IRS, many individuals qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) but cannot afford professional tax assistance.

Our Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program is a result of a collaboration between Pikes Peak United Way and the IRS. **We will be taking our first appointments this Saturday, January 27, 2018 at Pikes Peak United Way (518 N. Nevada Ave.). A volunteer will be available for on camera interviews from 10:30am-11:30am. Please contact me if you plan on attending.**
