Guide to El Pomar Emergency Fund Application

What the El Pomar Emergency Fund Is

The El Pomar Emergency Fund provides emergency grants to area nonprofit organizations for emergency direct client assistance and is available to any local non-profit organization (as defined by being exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code). The income from the grants is to be used to provide "direct assistance to those in need and may not be used for any overhead expenses associated with the fund. In addition, the endowment may not be spent or in other way encumbered."

How to Access the Application


New Account, click here



- Once clicked, you will be welcomed by the site, then you will be required to input all of your organizational information
- ❖ You then will be prompted to review the list of currently available grant applications
- Select El Pomar Emergency Fund 2019 as shown below



From here, confirm your information, and you will then be taken to your agency portal where you can access the application for the Emergency Fund, as shown below


