Family Success Center

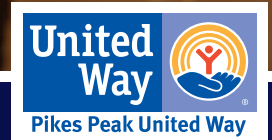
The future is bright!

Our Programs

COMMUNITY INVESTMENT FUND

This fund invests in the most efficient and effective programs, conducted by the top nonprofits in our city, improving youth success, family stability, and health.

Donations from community members fuel this fund and volunteers drive the decision-making to ensure the donated dollars make the most impact across the region.



COLORADO SPRINGS PROMISE

This initiative equips students to strive for a better future by promoting education, family involvement, workforce engagement, and family stability.

Through Colorado Springs Promise, students receive access to community resources, food distributions, mentorship, career coaching, and basic needs support. CSP is changing the lives of students, offering hope and support.

It is championing people at the beginning of their journey.

DOLLY PARTON'S IMAGINATION LIBRARY

Dolly was inspired by her father who never learned to read or write. DPIL mails a book each month to children, birth to age five.

It develops an early love of reading, prepares children for success in school, and provides bonding opportunities as parents read to their children. Pikes Peak United Way is the administrator for DPIL for El Paso and Teller Counties.

Since 2014, PPUW has mailed out over 500,000 books to children in the Pikes Peak Region.

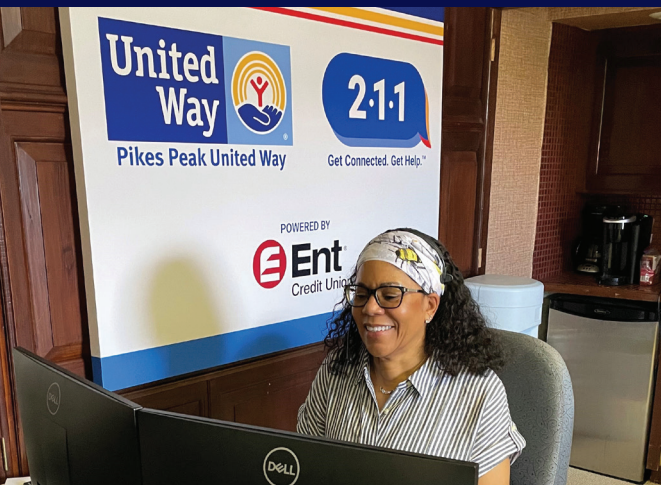


CHILD CARE CONTRIBUTION CREDIT (CCCC)

WITH YOUR SUPPORT through the Child Care Contribution Credit, we are partnering with multiple organizations to ensure children receive a strong start in our community. Your support empowers parents to provide for their families while trusting their children are in good hands.

This past year, support for the Child Care Contribution Credit provided more than 5,000 children with access to quality care and out-of-school time enrichment programs, as well as more than 4,000 parents and caregivers with resources and trainings to support children's development and education.

With a gift of \$250 of more directed to a Pikes Peak United Way CCCC eligible program you are eligible for a 50% tax credit on your state income taxes.



PIKES PEAK UNITED WAY 2-1-1

Staffed by compassionate community navigators, 2-1-1 is a free, confidential, and multilingual phone line that compassionately connects callers in need with personalized referrals for help.

For many of the 35,000 people who use 2-1-1, it is a lifeline, sometimes a lifesaver. 2-1-1 is sponsored by Ent Credit Union.
