Pikes Peak United Way to Host Alamosa Community Resource Event

Alamosa, Colo. — Pikes Peak United Way will host a free community resource event on Thursday, May 11, 2023, from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Boyd Elementary School, 1707 10th Street, Alamosa, CO., 81101.

The following community partners will also be available to answer additional questions and provide access to resources: Immigrant Resource Center, Alamosa Library, San Luis Valley Live Center, San Luis Valley Behavioral Health, San Luis Valley Housing Coalition, and the Energy Resource Center, along with Rocky Mountain SER and Alamosa County Public Health, among others. Pikes Peak United Way serves Alamosa, Conejos, Costilla, Chaffee, Cheyenne, El Paso, Lincoln, Mineral, Park, Rio Grande, Saguache, and Teller counties. This is the first of several trips Pikes Peak United Way plans to make to the Southern Colorado counties it serves.
