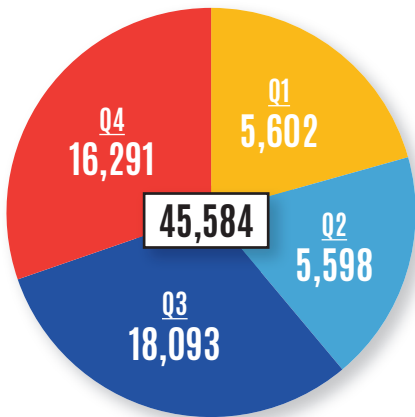

A Path to Stability: Connection That Changed Everything

In the week leading up to Christmas, a time of joy and excitement for many, one mother of three found herself overshadowed by fear and uncertainty.

Despite working full time at a local school district, she faced the daunting prospect of eviction on December 26, the day after Christmas.

As her children drifted off to sleep, dreaming of what the Christmas holiday had in store, she lay awake, grappling with uncertainty and growing fear about where she and her family would find shelter.

Fortunately, strong ties between Pikes Peak United Way and the school district, along with the countless resources at the Family Success Center, led to her being referred to services provided by PPUW. The Family Navigation Program swiftly partnered with the Community Economic Defense Project (CEDP), and within days, requests for essential rental relief were submitted.

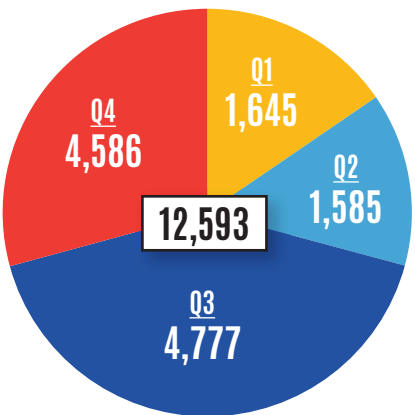
From her office at the Family Success Center, PPUW Family Navigator, Mira, played a crucial role in working with the landlord to explain the process. The landlord, recognizing the relief request had been submitted and was being reviewed, agreed to temporarily stop the eviction proceedings, allowing the program ample time to make a determination.

The rental assistance request was approved, successfully preventing the eviction and ensuring the safety of her family’s housing.

Expressing her gratitude, the mother shared, “I was able to get it all sorted out,” she said. “Mira was AWESOME! She stayed in contact with me through the whole process. I can’t thank you enough!”

A total of 45,584 impacts were recorded at the Family Success Center during the 2025 calendar year.

These impacts represent individuals who accessed resources through our partner agencies, such as receiving food from the Sunny Side Market, eviction assistance from CEDP, or childcare services from the Lighthouse.

Community organizations also utilized the FSC to host meetings, while others conducted independent meetings within our center. Additionally, various organizations held events that brought individuals into our facility, further increasing community engagement and access to services.
